Trees..shade & ornamental..Maintenance has been able to keep the basic pruning & general clean up program on schedule and has made excellent progress reducing work order backlog caused by weather and “people” shortages earlier this year. Security Committee Report

Earlier this month there were several reports to the Stratford Police Department regarding residents reporting unlocked vehicles being rifled. Stratford Police noted that this was not confined just to Oronoque Village and that similar reports had come in from the surrounding Stratford neighborhood. Their view is that this is being done by young people in the area looking for electronics like cell phones, portable GPS units etc. Mark has sent an e-mail to all Villagers reminding them that the SPD asks them to “practice due diligence” and lock their cars when parked outside at all times —not just at night. Additionally the SPD also asks OV Residents to contact them to report sightings of suspicious persons in their areas.
